! RULE OF THE MONTH !

Rule: It is a violation when a player leaves the playing court at the endline to avoid a 3-second violation and then re-enters the restricted area (key).

Interpretation: You cannot avoid a 3 second in the key (restricted area) by exiting the court/key via the baseline. This will be called as a 3 second violation.

! SCORING TIP OF THE MONTH !

Q: When should the clock be started at the commencement of a game?

A: When the ball is legally tapped by a jumper.

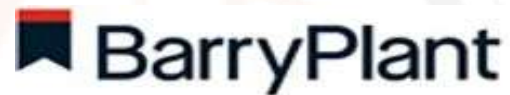
