Training is held at Bayswater North Primary School gym.

Games are held at various locations around the Knox area on Saturdays or Sundays. Games times vary each week but your Team Manager will contact you each week to keep you up to date.

Entry Fee to the stadiums (as at Feb 2025):

Saturday \$3.50 Free for spectators Under 5

Sunday \$3.50 Free for spectators Under 14

Please also find attached the spectators and players 'Code of Conduct'. We encourage parents to support their children in their basketball; but please also keep in mind to let the:

Players play, Coaches coach and Referees referee.

In the event that your child is injured on court, **NO-ONE** (not even the coach) is allowed on the court until the referee signals their permission. The coach may then assist the player from the court to receive attention as required; the parents do not enter the court at any time.

REGISTRATION

ALL players MUST register on the PLAYHQ website to play.

CLUB FEES

A seasonal fee is due in March (for Winter season commencing in May) and Sept (for Summer season commencing in Oct/Nov).

This amount covers your child's registration and team sheet fees for the home and away season.

- Saturday Comp U8-U16s \$215
- Sunday Comp U19-U23s \$195

Please note we are unable to enter players into teams until club registration has been paid and player details entered into PlayHQ before each season.

A late fee is applicable for registering after the cut-off date.
