



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What are the costs involved to play with KSC Phoenix?

- Annual registration fee with Basketball Victoria through PlayHQ
- KSC Phoenix season registration fee; including weekly game fees
- Uniform
- Stadium entry fee on game day

How much is the PlayHQ registration (Basketball Victoria)?

2023 (as of January 1, 2023)

- \$29 – Junior (17 and under) playing participant
- \$43 – Senior (18 and over) playing participant
- \$5.50 Basketball Victoria Levy is also payable
(These fees are annually and cover a player for all associations within Victoria).

What are the KSC Phoenix Fees?

Saturday Comp U8-U16s \$215

Sunday Comp U19-U23s \$195

This includes our registration and game fees.

How do I join a team?

How do I register to play?

When do we pay fees?

A seasonal fee is due in March (for Winter season commencing in May) and Sept (for Summer season commencing in Nov).

How do I pay my fees?

All payments must be made via the PlayHQ website.

Can I pay in smaller amounts over time?

When are games played?

Saturday for under 8 to under 16 and Sunday afternoon/evening for under 19 and under 23.

Where are games played?

All games venues are within the Knox community, with the majority of games played at the State Basketball Centre (Wantirna South) and Knox Basketball Stadium (Boronia).

When and where is training held?

All training sessions are held at Bayswater North Primary School. The day and time will depend on which team you are in.

What sign-up incentives do you offer?

\$80 registration component of this fee will be waived in a player's first season to help offset their uniform purchase.

When do the seasons run?

Summer season runs from November to May.

Winter season runs from May to October.

Dates will change slightly each year.

Are games during the school holidays or on long weekends?

No, not usually, but check the fixture to make sure.

How do I know when and where a game is?

Your Team Manager will contact you each week with this information; alternatively you can check the fixtures at the PlayHQ website.

How do I get a new uniform?

How much does the uniform cost?

A new uniform (singlet and shorts) is \$90.
